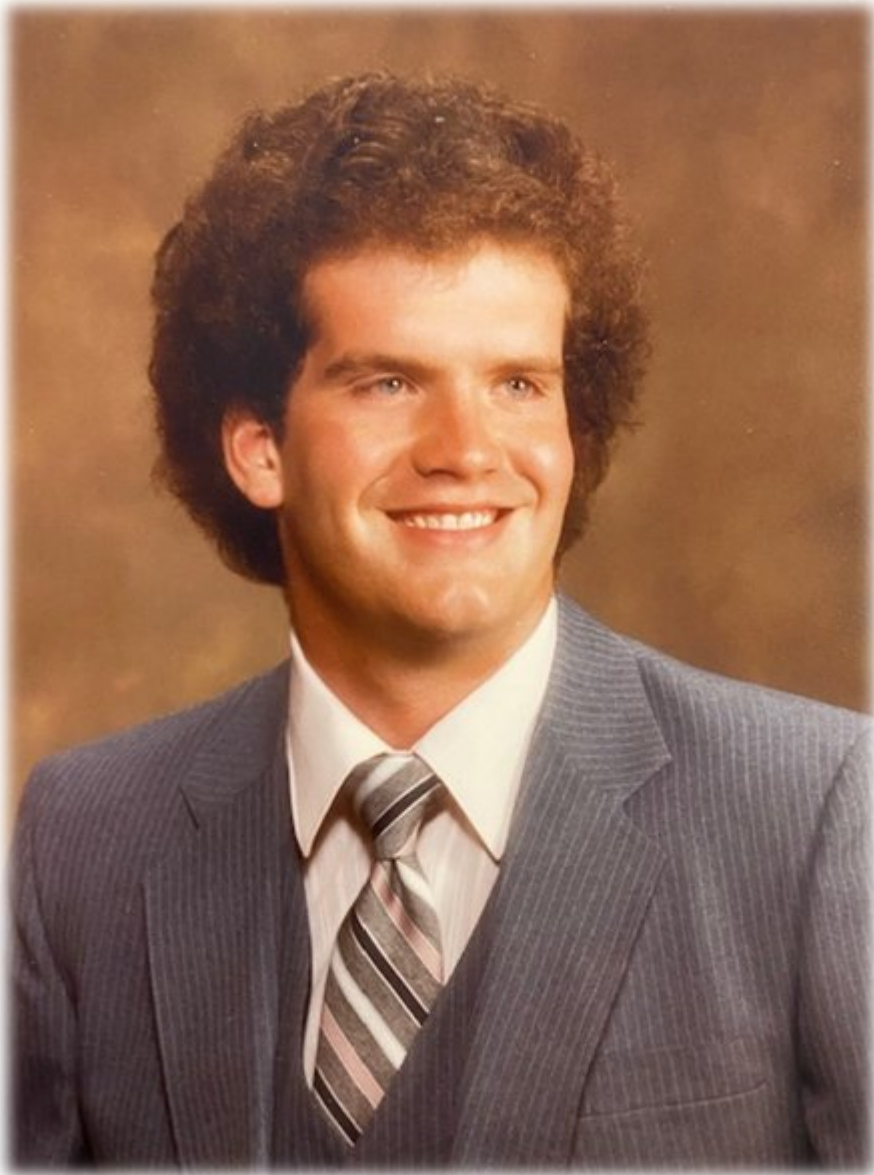


Bill Herman
