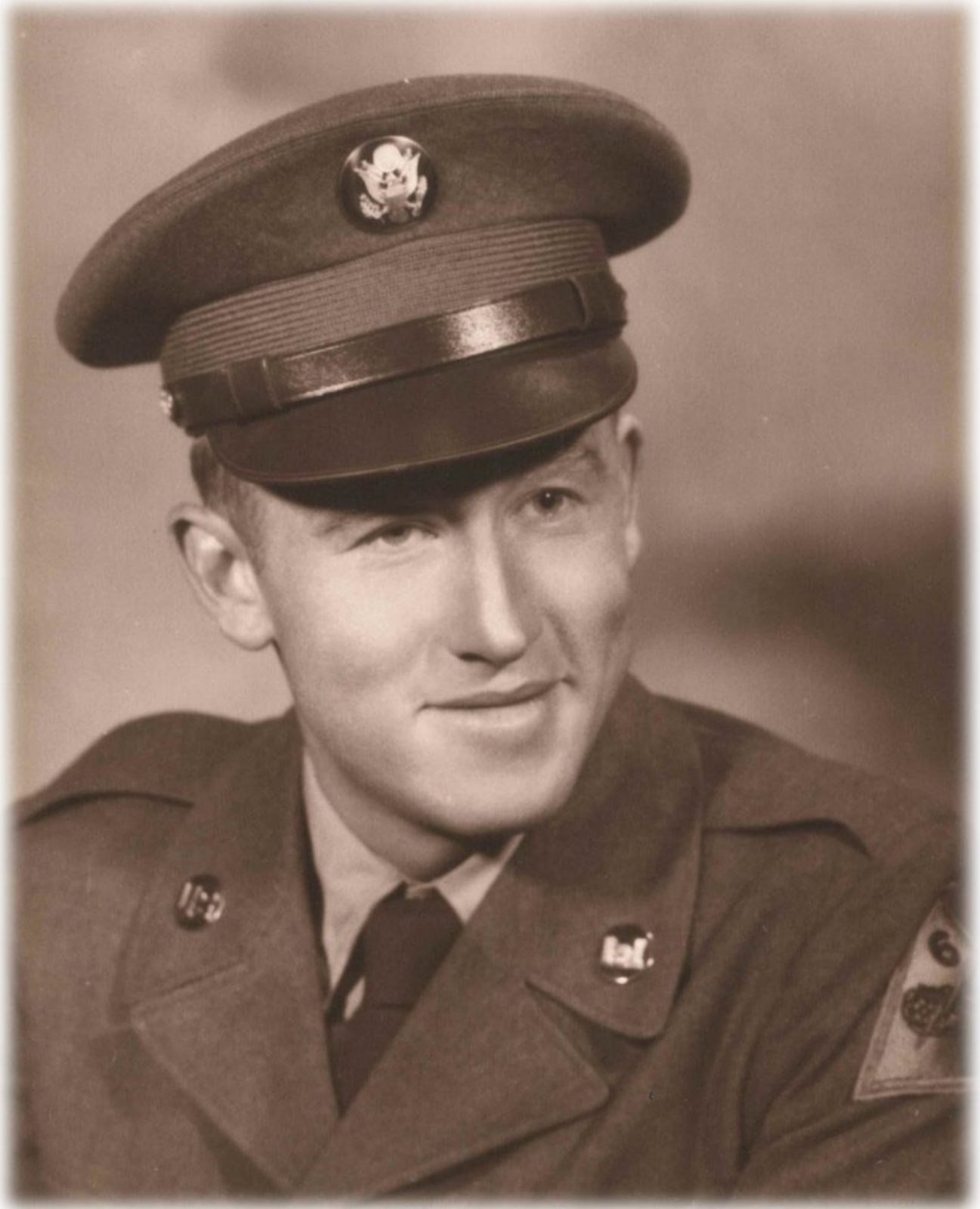


# James G. Linhart

In 1992, Jimmy met Lori and they were married in 1995. They were blessed with many happy years together living on their acreage. In addition, for many years, they enjoyed selling their home grown produce and homemade items at the Farmer's Market in Blair, Nebraska.
