He returned to full-time trucking, hauling corn cobs from South Dakota to Quaker Oats processing plant in Omaha, Nebraska. After retiring from trucking he became a car jockey for the Ratigan Dealership driving and hauling new vehicles as far South as the Mexican Border, Mesa, Arizona, Miami, Florida, New Jersey Shore and Canadian Border. Jack was a member of First Lutheran Church, he enjoyed working in his garden and keeping his yard manicured.
