Thomas A. Seamann age 74, of Missouri Valley, Iowa passed away on Saturday, November 18, 2017 at Bergan Mercy Hospital in Omaha, Nebraska. Tom was born in Burwell, Nebraska on June 1, 1943 to Boniface and Rosella (Matya) Seamann where he was the eldest of four children. He attended school until the age of 17 and then joined the Navy and was stationed out of San Diego, CA serving on the USS Ranger as a 3rd Class Engineman from 1961-1963.
